ARTICLE 01 ORGANISATION.

The 3rd edition of the Grand Prix ISBERGUES Pas-de-Calais Féminin is organized by the association for the organisation of the Grand Prix Isbergues, under the regulations of the French Cycling Federation. It takes place on Sunday September 20, 2020.

ARTICLE 02 TYPE OF EVENT.

The event is reserved for athletes in the Women Elite categories. It is on the UCI world calendar. The event is classified in class WE 1.2 In accordance with UCI regulations and the scale of article 2.10.008, it awards the following points: 40, 30, 25, 20, 15, 10, 5, 3, 3, 3 for the first 10 classified riders.

ARTICLE 03 PARTICIPATION.

In accordance with article 2.1.005 of the UCI regulations, the event is open to the following teams: UCI Women, National teams, Regional or club teams, mixed teams.

The number of riders per team is a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 6 riders.

The maximum number of participants is limited to 176. Registration of participants is by team.

ARTICLE 04 PERMANENCE.

The permanence of the departure is on Sunday September 20, 2020 from 7:15 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. at the town hall, Place Émile Basly in Isbergues.

The confirmation of the starters and the withdrawal of the numbers by the team managers are done at the town hall, Place Émile Basly in Isbergues, from 7:15 a.m. to 8:20 a.m. on Sunday, September 20, 2020.

The meeting of sports directors, organized in accordance with article 1.2.087 of the UCI regulations, in the presence of the members of the College of Commissioners, is set for 8:35 am on Sunday September 20, 2020 and will take place at the town hall, Place Émile Basly in Isbergues.

The arrivals are on Sunday September 20 from 13:00 p.m. to 16:00 p.m. at the town hall, Place Émile Basly in Isbergues.

ARTICLE 05 RADIO-TOUR.

The race information will be transmitted on the frequency of 157.575 MHz.

ARTICLE 06 NEUTRAL TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.

Neutral technical support is provided by Assistance Sport Media. The service is provided by means of 2 cars.

ARTICLE 07 DEPART.

The competitors must present themselves on the protocol podium for the signature control in racing clothes. For an optimal organization, the list containing the times of passage of the teams on the protocol podium for the signing will be sent beforehand to the sporting director of each team.

ARTICLE 08 ARRIVAL TIME.

Any competitor arriving within 8% of the winner's time is no longer retained in the classification. The deadline may be increased in exceptional circumstances by the College of Commissioners, in consultation with the organizer (Article 2.3.039 of the UCI regulations).

Any competitor in a group or isolated, pointed more than 10 minutes from the main peloton must stop and leave the race.

ARTICLE 09 PRICES.

Any competitor in a group or isolated, pointed more than 10 minutes from the main peloton must stop and leave the race.

ARTICLE 10 CLASSIFICATION.

10.1 - GPM :

The classification is disputed over all 6 mountains listed in the event. Each mountain is awarded: 5 points for the 1st rider, 3 points for the 2nd and 1 point for the 3rd.

The final classification is made by adding the points. In the event of equality, the competitors are decided on the basis of the best place in the classification at the finish.

A bonus in the amount of € 200, awarded by «DESK NORD - KODEN», rewards the 1st in this ranking.

10.2 – SPRINT PRICES :

The Sprint Price classification is disputed over all 3 sprints listed in the event. Each sprint is awarded: 5 points for the 1st rider, 3 points for the 2nd and 1 point for the 3rd.

The final classification is made by adding the points. In the event of equality, the competitors are decided on the basis of the best place in the classification at the finish.

A bonus in the amount of € 200 awarded by «Toyota FG Automobiles Béthune» rewards the 1st in this classification.

10.3 – COMBATIVITY PRICE :

A bonus in the amount of € 100 awarded by « Soluce Expert Conseil», rewards the most combative competitor, who is appointed by the Race Direction.

10.4 - PRIX DE LA MEILLEURE JEUNE :

Une prime d'un montant de 100€ attribuée par le Conseil Régional des Hauts-de-France récompense la meilleure jeune, née depuis le 1er janvier 1995, au classement général officiel de l'épreuve.

10.5 – SPRINT « LE 62 » :

The Pas-de-Calais Departmental Council awards a bonus in the amount of € 100 to the competitor who passes the first line of the Sprint "le 62", located at kilometer 49.1 in the town of HAM EN ARTOIS

10.6 – DOSSARD VERT :

The competitor named « Dossard Vert » receives a bonus of € 50,- awarded by « Europe Services Propreté ». It is designated by the race director to be the most respectful of the environmental guidelines set by the organisation.

With regard to the special prices, it is recalled that in order to be eligible for these prices, the winners must have completed the event, appear in the final classification and participate in the official ceremony. These bonuses will be paid by the organising committee on the protocol podium.

ARTICLE 11 ANTI-DOPING.

The UCI anti-doping apply full regulations to this event. In addition, French anti-doping legislation is applied in accordance with the provisions of the law in force. Medical checks are carried out, under the authority of the UCI and designated officials, near the finish line.

ARTICLE 12 PROTOCOL.

In accordance with article 1.2.112 of the UCI regulations, the following competitors must attend the protocol:

- The first 3 of the event.
- The winner of the "GPM".
- The winner of the "Sprints Price".
- The winner of the "Sprint Le 62".
- The best youngster of the event.
- The winner of the "Price for Combativeness".
- The winner of the "Dossard vert".

They will present themselves at the official podium **within a maximum of 10 minutes after their arrival.**

In case of absence on the podium of the competitors, the Organiser reserves the right to take certain measures such as the non-delivery of prices.

ARTICLE 13 PENALTIES.

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

FOLLOWERS INSTRUCTIONS

Extract from the regulations of the Union Cycliste Internationale:

art. 2.2.035

All race followers, except accredited journalists and guests of honor who do not drive vehicles, must be licensed.

The team car must have on board a licensed sports director as such, as responsible for the vehicle. For vehicles of teams registered with the UCI, this sports director must also be registered as such with the UCI.

art. 2.2.036

It is forbidden for all followers to throw any object whatsoever along the parcours.

art. 2.2.037

Any spraying from a vehicle is prohibited.

1 OFFICIAL VEHICLES

Official vehicles will be parked in the official vehicle parking lot located rue Grévy (see departure / arrival map). At 11:20 am, the drivers will take possession of their vehicle and will stand on the RD186 on the starting line. Will be placed in front of the peloton:

- The race director's car.
- The car of the general manager and deputy general manager.
- The judge's car on arrival.
- The commissioner's car 1.
- The medical inspector's car.
- The motorcycles of the commissaires.
- Motorcycles info, regulator, slate and intermediate classifications

Behind the peloton:

- The car of the president of the jury
- The commissioner's car 2
- The cars of the race doctors
- Ambulances

At the end of the event, the drivers will drop off the officials at the finish line and go to the guest vehicle parking lot.

2 NEUTRAL SERVICE VEHICLES

Neutral recovery vehicles will also be parked in the official vehicle parking lot located rue Jules Grevy (see departure / arrival map).

At 10:20 am, the drivers will take possession of their vehicle and will stand on the RD 186 on the starting line.

Two cars and a motorcycle will be placed in front of the peloton. The 3rd car will be placed behind the sports directors. At the end of the event, these vehicles must leave the circuit and take the detour, 300 m before the finish line on the right side of the road.

3 SPORTDIRECTORS' VEHICLES

The sports directors' vehicles will be parked on the RD186 at the post office (see start / finish plan).

As soon as the event starts, they will take their places behind the peloton in the order designated by the toss.

At the end of the event, these vehicles must leave the circuit and take the detour (300 m before the finish line on the right side of the road).

4 PRESS VEHICLES

The press vehicles will be parked in the "Press" car park located on rue Grévy (see departure / arrival map).

At 10:20 am, the drivers will take possession of their vehicle and stand on the RD 186 in front of the peloton. During the event, motorcycles (press, radio, etc.) may under no circumstances "park" immediately in front of the peloton.

At the end of the event, these vehicles must leave the circuit before the last lap and take the detour (300 m before the finish line on the right side of the road).

5 GUEST VEHICLES

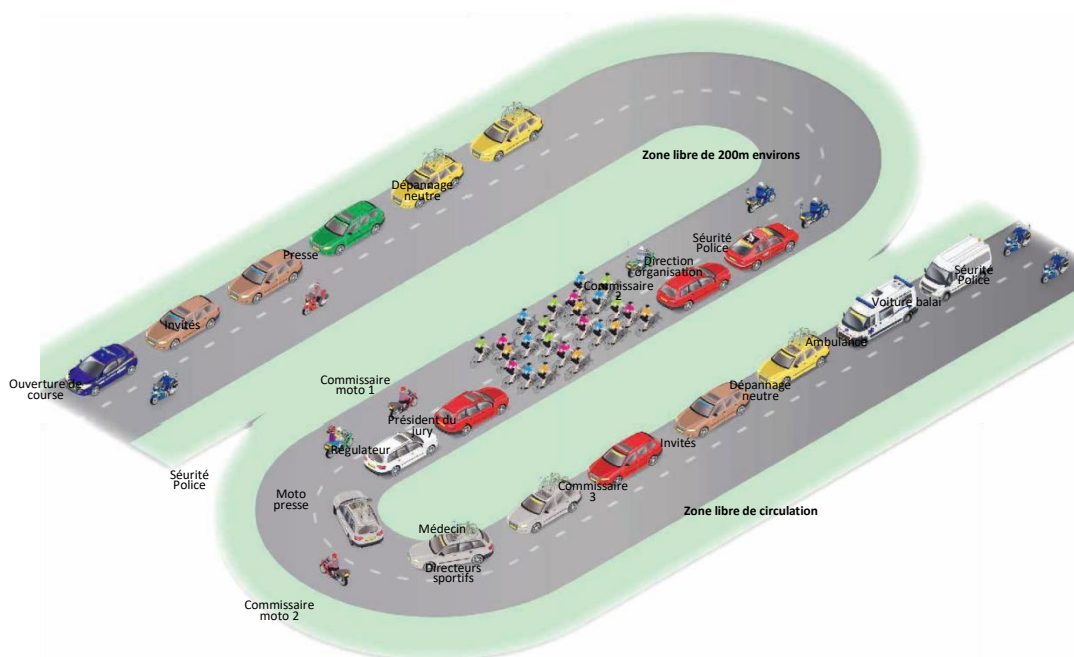
The guest vehicles will be parked in the «Guest Vehicles» parking lot located near the V.I.P. village. They will leave after departure. They will have to leave the race after a final loop and go to the «Guest vehicles» parking lot.

6 AMBULANCES AND BROOM CAR

These vehicles are required to cross the finish line.

7 PRIORITY VEHICLES

A red disc will be affixed to priority vehicles, giving them priority of passage in all cases.

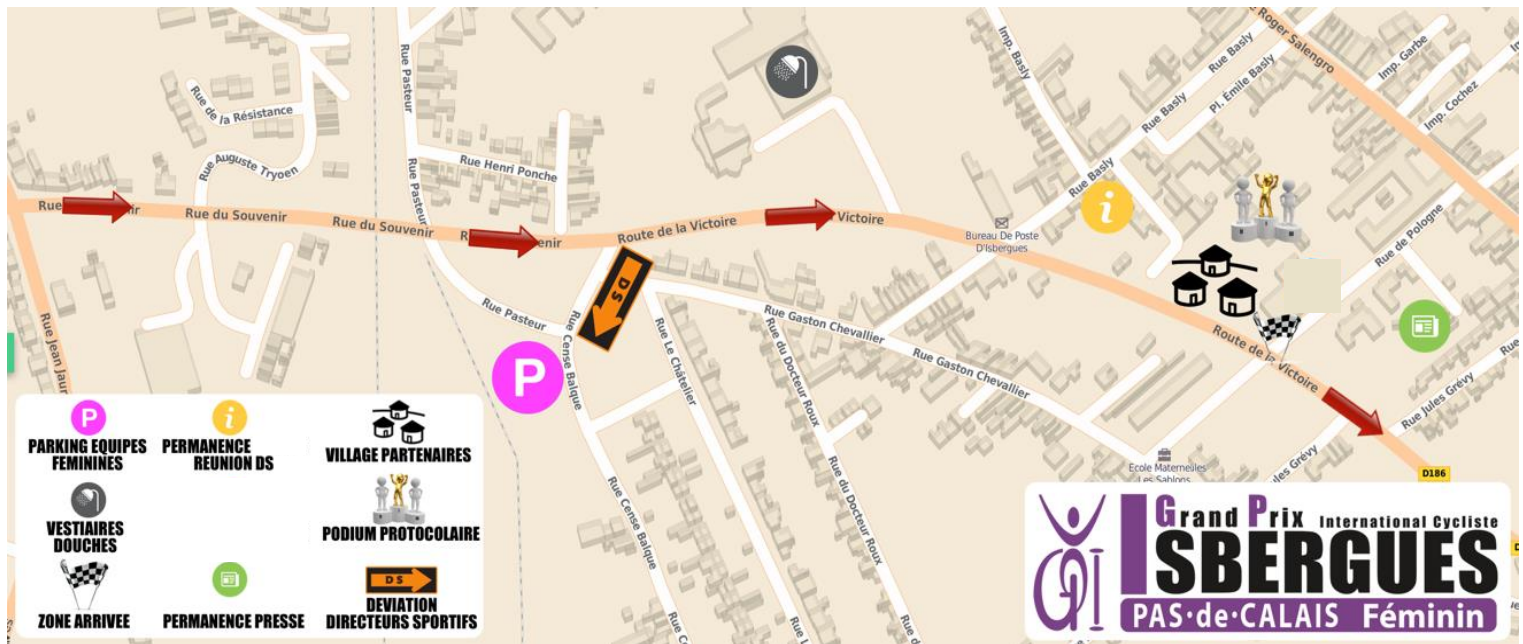

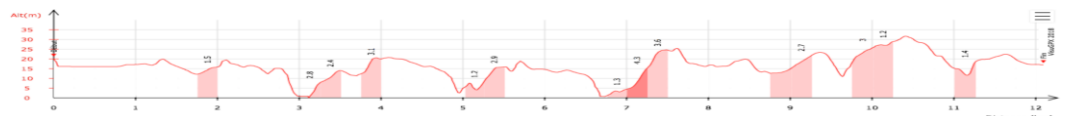


PROFIL BOUCLE DES MONTS



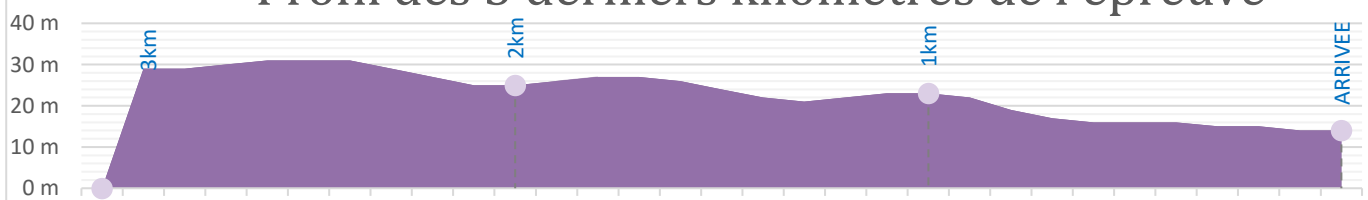


PROFIL BOUCLE FINALE
